Christian III and Queen Dorothea ordered 7.500 vines in Sachsen in 1558 for use near by and founded a brewery in the town.

The Royal family and The state of Denmark's Crown Jewels collection the Castle of Rosenborg

Here were King Christian the IV grape collection,
Imported to the household 40 vine in 1607 and 200 to a vineyard beside the castle
Chasselas (White van der Lahn), white Muscatell, Early Pinot Noir (Magdalene),
In green house: Frankentahler (Trollinger) and Tokay Rose
