Floréal (an interspecific hybrid) was obtained by INRA and results from the interspecific crossbreeding of Villaris and INRA 3159-2-12.

Synonymy

There is no officially recognized synonym in France nor in the other countries of the European Union, for this variety.

In France, Floreal is officially listed in the "Catalogue of vine varieties" since 2018 on the A list and classified.
